### Petersham Station footbridge work

From Saturday 2 November to Sunday 3 November 2024

#### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance work at Petersham Station from Saturday 2 November to Sunday 3 November to protect the footbridge steelwork from corrosion and extend the life of the structure. We will be repainting a section of the footbridge which involves painting work.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

#### How this affects you

#### **Noise**

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place from 4am to 8pm Saturday 2 November and Sunday 3 November.
- Work activities will include vacuum cleaning and compressors. We will select low-noise compressors and equipment, where low-noise alternatives are available.
- To reduce the noise level, noise blankets and other noise reduction aids will be implemented during the work.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

#### Footbridge access

Pedestrians will be able to access the station platform from Terminus Street and Trafalgar Street entrances.

#### **Traffic and Parking**

- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Parts of Terminus Street will be blocked off for loading and unloading of materials throughout the weekend.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
