


Temporary road closures, Oxley Highway, Mount Seaview from 30 January

Oxley Highway

January 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Birpai people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is funding essential reconstruction work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to reinstate full access through natural disaster affected areas.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW is continuing major restoration work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to return the road to pre-2021/2022 flood condition. Work includes:

- Establishing a temporary work site
- Major earthworks and some vegetation removal
- Soil nailing to stabilise slip sites
- Shotcreting to provide embankment support
- Using heavy machinery to carry out work
- Installing improved drainage.

When and where we'll be working

As part of this work, the Oxley Highway will be closed temporarily between Knodingbul and Forbes River roads from **Tuesday 30 January**, while we carry out restoration work at Slip 4 and Slip 22.

Access to Mount Seaview Road will be maintained for motorists and residents after clearing the Forbes River Road checkpoint.

We expect the full road closures to be in place until about Easter 2024.

Road closure times

The Oxley Highway will be closed temporarily from:

Tuesday to Thursday, 7am to 4.30pm and Fridays, 7am to 3pm.

No closures will be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays, Mondays or any public holidays.

Working hours

Standard working hours are Monday to Friday from 7am to 5pm and Saturdays from 8am to 12pm. Work on Saturdays may continue until 5pm with the prior approval of the project team.

Traffic changes

Please follow the direction of traffic controllers who will be present at the road closure points.

Plan your journey, avoid the area during closure times and defer the trip if possible.

Plan an alternative route via Waterfall Way or New England Highway if your trip must take place during the closure period.


Community event exception dates

- Friday 9 February (Walcha Cup Race Meeting)
- Friday 16 February (Walcha Antique Machinery and Truck Show)
- Friday 23 February (Red Hot Summer, Port Macquarie)
- Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March (Walcha Show).
