What's happening in February?

In February, our team we will continue work on Lawson, Ivy, Wilson and Little Eveleigh streets.

This will include:

- roadwork, including line marking, installing a traffic island and paving (subject to approvals)
- installing light poles, signposts and signs
- rectification work on the new Southern entrance bridge and building
- relocating bicycle hoops
- canopy work on the station platforms.

Mid-week night work

For on one night in February, we will work in Lawson Street to do line marking work.

Nearby residents will be given further information when the date of the work is confirmed.

When and where we'll work

Our standard construction hours are:

7am-6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am-6pm Saturday. For the safety of our workers and the community, some work will take place outside the standard hours.

In February, we will work on the following weekends:

- 6am Saturday 3 February to 6pm Sunday 4 February
- 6am Saturday 10 February to 6pm Sunday 11 February

What does this mean for you?

While the work is underway, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- noise and vibration from machinery and equipment, such as grinders, jackhammers, power saws, rattle guns, rock hammers/breakers, rollers, asphalt trucks, whacker-packers, excavators and vacuum trucks.

Traffic and parking impacts

Nearby residents will be given further information of the traffic and parking impacts when the dates of the roadwork is confirmed.

Managing our impacts

We reduce noise and vibration by turning off machinery when not in use and, where possible, use noise absorbing blankets.
