

Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration

May - July 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

We are upgrading rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal at Central Station and Erskineville Junction to ensure new trains on the South Coast Line can access platforms 1 to 14.

What work are we doing?

To enable work on this project, we will be using the Redfern Yard (see image on back page) as a temporary laydown area to store materials. In order to minimise impacts on local residents, we have secured alternate, off-site parking for staff vehicles and do not anticipate to require this location for parking purposes on a frequent basis.

You may notice some deliveries, however this work is not expected to be noisy.

When we'll be working?

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**
