


# South Mosman Wharf Upgrade

# **Construction update – temporary changes to 111 bus service**



August 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Borogegal and Cameraygal as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

South Mosman Wharf is being upgraded as part of the Safe Accessible Transport program to make public transport safe, inclusive, and easy to use for all passengers, especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and people with limited mobility.

### What work are we doing?

Installing new metal balustrades and handrails along the footpath at the bottom of Musgrave Street.

# When and where we'll be working

To install the balustrades the Musgrave Street turning circle will need to close to all buses from Monday 5 August to Monday 16 September from 6am to 4pm, Monday to Friday.

Buses will run in their usual route on weekday afternoons, weeknights and throughout the weekend. Private vehicles will have full access to Musgrave Street.

#### **Bus services**

Buses will still be running but will need to turn around on Raglan Street at the Musgrave Street intersection on weekdays for this **six-week period**.

Residents will be able to catch the 111 bus towards Military Road at the bus stop on Raglan Street at Musgrave Street (ID 2088154).

School buses will turn around and allow students to exit the bus at the bus stop on Raglan Street at

Musgrave Street (ID 2088154). This means they do not need to cross Raglan Street unattended.

As this is a temporary arrangement, the travel apps may not reflect this change.

#### What will this mean for you?

During construction in August and September, you may notice:

- workers and large vehicles accessing Musgrave Street
- traffic controllers and signage
- reduced speed limits
- temporary footpath closures around the turning circle
- noise from machinery and equipment if cutting into rock.

## Managing our impacts

Some of our work may be noisy at times. We will minimise impacts to the community, by turning off equipment when not in use and placing equipment as far away as possible from residents.


