



South Mosman Wharf Upgrade

Night work

South Mosman Wharf is being upgraded as part of the Safe Accessible Transport program to make public transport safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers, especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and people with limited mobility.

Further to our email notification on Tuesday 24 September, night work to install piles for the new pontoon will continue until **Friday 25 October**, weather and maritime conditions permitting.

Work will take place over **four night shifts**, consisting of **two consecutive night shifts** followed by a five night

break, then another two night shifts. Night shift hours will take place between **8pm and 5am**. All other construction activities will continue to take place during standard work hours from **7am to 5pm**. Additional night work is scheduled for November and we will notify the community ahead of these activities, in the coming weeks. Thank you for your understanding and patience while we carry out this important work.
