## The NSW Government is improving accessibility at St Peters Station

Earlier this year, Transport for NSW completed upgrades to the station master's office and installed family accessible toilet facilities .

After listening to the community, we are designing a step-free pathway from Goodsell Street through May Lane to St Peters Station.

Transport are working with the Inner West Council on a design, which includes:

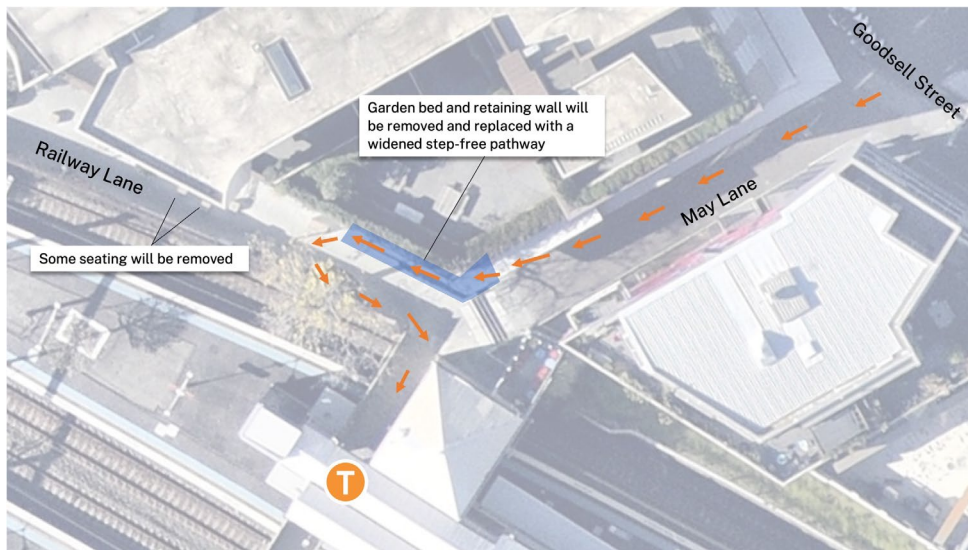
- a step-free pathway created by removing the existing garden bed and retaining wall on Railway Lane
- the removal of some seating along Railway Lane to improve access.

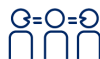
