Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link - Stage 2 East

Community update

February/March 2024

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient and enjoyable transport option.

What work are we doing?

Day time work

Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**. We are continuing construction at the following locations:

Work at **Denman Avenue from Gannons Road to Banksia Road** includes:

- temporary lane changes to enable construction
- continued construction of active transport link
- continued removal of trees, trimming overhead branches, as approved
- landscaping, new signage and line marking.

Work at **Kingsway/Willarong Road intersection** includes paving of footpath areas and landscaping.

Night time work

Our night work hours are **6pm to 5am, Sunday to Friday.** We are continuing construction at the following locations and as shown on the maps overleaf:

- Kingsway/Willarong Road to Taren Point Road
- Kingsway/Willarong Road intersection upgrade
- Kingsway/Taren Point Road intersection upgrade
- Kingsway/Kareena Road intersection upgrade
- Gannons Road/Denman Avenue intersection upgrade.

What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, sucker trucks, dump trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, asphalt milling machines, asphalters, delivery trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes
- temporary fencing for safety and security
- traffic controllers to assist drivers
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use.

We will work with nearby residents and businesses and provide notification ahead of work in the area.

Temporary driveway closures

We will work closely with residents where temporary driveway closures are required to carry out construction, previous arrangement with residents and construction requirements.

Temporary parking changes

The Kingsway/Willarong Road (south) council car park will be **temporarily closed for up to seven days**, to enable construction work at the driveway, weather permitting.

Temporary parking removal on Denman Avenue (east bound) from Banksia Road to Gannons Road will be required during February and March to enable safe construction work zone. Please refer to on site signage before parking. Alternative parking is available on local streets.

Extended night work hours on Kingsway

During December 2023, we asked residents and businesses within 100m of Kingsway (westbound) from Willarong Road to Taren Point Road, Caringbah for feedback on our proposal to extend night time work hours. Please see map below.

Based on the community feedback received, we have approved work for up to five nights a week. The approval is subject to ongoing review and compliance checks.

These extended night work hours would allow us to complete construction sooner than originally planned.
