


Sydney Harbour Bridge Cycleway Northern Access Project

Project award and site investigations

May 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cammeraygal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering a new ramp and cycle path from the Sydney Harbour Bridge cycleway to the bike network in Milsons Point. The project will improve the cycling experience for all bike users at this iconic landmark.



In March 2024 Transport for NSW (Transport) appointed Arenco (NSW) Pty Ltd to build the Sydney Harbour Bridge Cycleway Northern Access Project.

Construction is expected to commence in mid-2024 and take around 18 months to complete.

We are now planning site investigations to help inform detailed design and site establishment.

The investigations will be carried out in Bradfield Park North and along Alfred Street South and Lavender St in Milsons Point.

What work are we doing?

Site investigations will involve:

- services investigations to determine the location of underground utilities
- geotechnical investigations to take soil and water samples
- survey investigations to help inform detail design
- arborist assessment of trees and root mapping to identify structural root zones.

When and where we'll be working

This work is scheduled to start from Tuesday 14 May 2024 and take about three months to complete, weather permitting. Most of our work will take place during the day from **7am** to **6pm Monday to Friday**.

For the safety of the public and our workers and to minimise traffic impacts, we may carry out the geotechnical investigations near Lavender Street and Alfred Street South outside standard construction hours. This work will generally take place between **9pm** and **5am** and is expected to take up to three nights to complete, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

There will be some temporary changes for pedestrians and cyclists when we're working next to footpaths and at the station entrance. Traffic controllers will be in place to provide directions. Equipment to be used includes a vacuum truck, small drilling rig and hand tools which will move between sites.


Managing our impacts

We will minimise impacts to the community and the environment by:

- reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using nontonal reversing beepers
- installing noise blankets where possible
- installing signage and having traffic controllers there to direct pedestrians.
