## Sydney Harbour Bridge

From Monday 24 June to Thursday 1 August 2024

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the timber deck supporting the track on the Sydney Harbour Bridge with a concrete composite deck. The work is being completed in stages during scheduled weeknight and weekend rail closedowns. The new deck will strengthen the structure, extend the life of the rail corridor, simplify track maintenance and, when complete, reduce train noise for nearby residents.

Work will take place from Monday 24 June to Thursday 1 August and includes removal of scaffolding.

We understand that this work will have an impact on you and appreciate your patience and understanding.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night.
- **Works will take place from:**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 24 June to Thursday 27 June**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 1 July to Thursday 4 July**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 8 July to Thursday 11 July**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 15 July to Thursday 18 July**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 22 July to Thursday 25 July**
  - **6pm to 4.30am Monday 29 July to Thursday 1 August.**

#### Traffic and Parking

- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Trucks will be used during this time to transport scaffolding from the Pylon to Lower Fort Street.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.

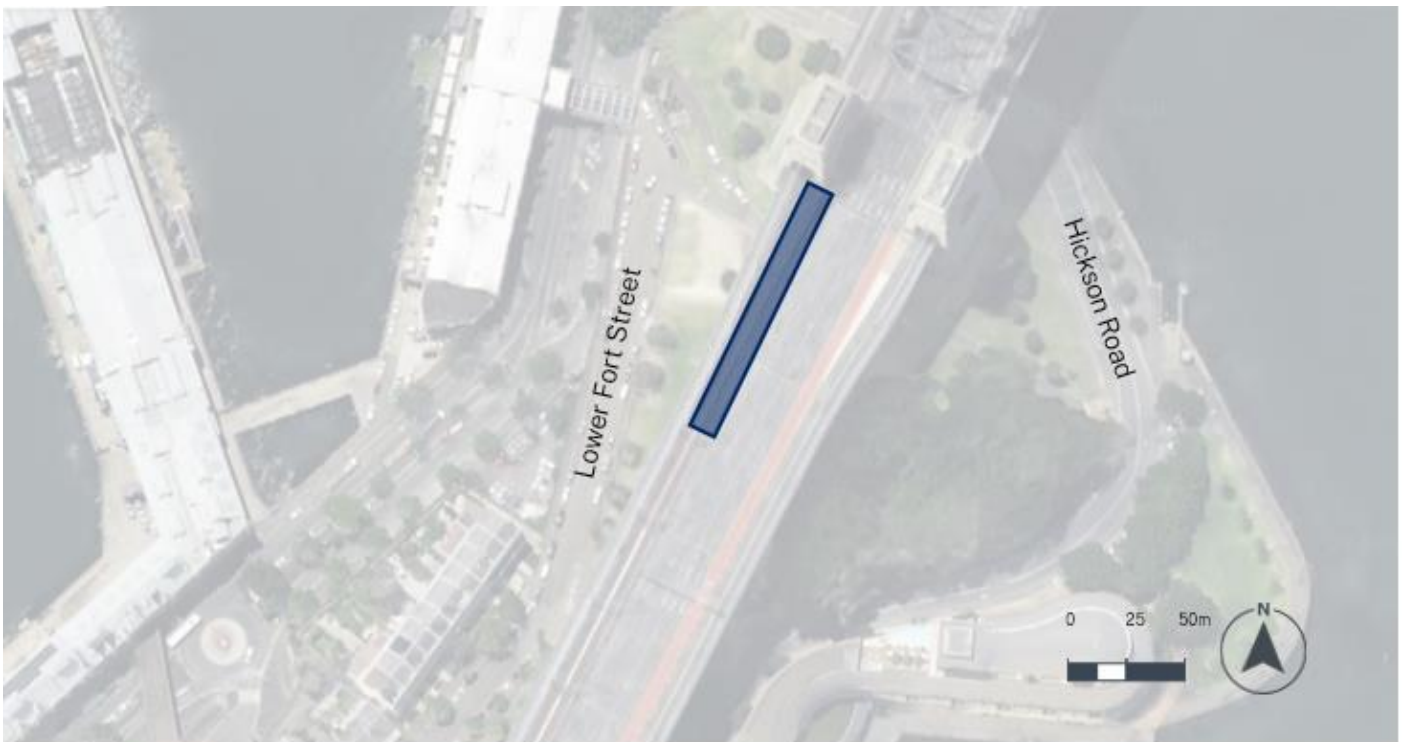
