Sydney Harbour Bridge

From Friday 6 September to Monday 9 September 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the timber deck supporting the track on the Sydney Harbour Bridge with a concrete composite deck. The work is being completed in stages during scheduled weeknight and weekend rail closedowns. The new deck will strengthen the structure, extend the life of the rail corridor, simplify track maintenance and, when complete, reduce train noise for nearby residents.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place from 11pm Friday 6 September to 5am Monday 9 September.
- Work activities include plant movement within the rail corridor from Blue Street Carpark to the north and southern approaches of the Sydney Harbour Bridge. Blue Street will be used as the main access point for plant and materials to the work location.
- Machinery will be used throughout works; we will select low-noise equipment when available.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Two northbound lanes on the Sydney Harbour Bridge will be closed overnight from 11pm Friday 6 September to 3am Saturday 7 September as the space will be required for safe delivery of plant and materials to the worksite.
- Blue Street Carpark in North Sydney will be used as the main access point for plant and materials to the work location.
- From 6pm Friday 6 September to 4pm Saturday 7 September kerb side parking along Upper Fort Street between Argyle Street and the entrance to Fort Street Public School will be temporarily removed.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that onstreet parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
- Work vehicles will use local streets to access the worksite.


