



Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade

Rail Service Improvement Program

November and December 2024

The Rail Service Improvement Program, formerly known as More Trains, More Services enables a safer, more equitable, and integrated transport network where people can travel more safely, reliably, and efficiently across NSW.

What work are we doing?

The Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade project in Schofields will be completed by end of 2024, with final upgrades to the overhead wiring infrastructure occurring along the rail corridor in November and December (subject to work approvals).

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor at Schofields from Swordfish Street through to Advance Street.

Temporary site access points and temporary parking removal will be established along the rail corridor.

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

Out of hours work

In November and December, some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours.

This work will take place between **6am Saturday 30 November and 6pm Sunday 1 December 2024**.

Why we work outside of construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice an increase in workers and construction vehicles, elevated working platforms, and noise at times from equipment including hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible, including:

- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- ensuring lighting towers are directed downwards and away from residents
- compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise.
