The Safe Accessible Transport program aims to make public transport safe, inclusive, and easy to use for all passengers, especially people with disabilities, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who may be experiencing mobility issues.

This program aims to achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport (DSAPT) compliance, improving amenity, access and safety and acknowledging the important role these locations have to the communities they serve.

The NSW Government has funded early planning and strategic concept designs to improve accessibility and safety at Tascott Station.

Benefits

The design of each accessibility upgrade will be tailored to the local area and developed with the community's suggestions and ideas in mind.

The design of the upgrade at Tascott Station will consider:

- installation of new lifts to the existing footbridge
- platform widening
- two new accessible car spaces
- new kiss and ride zone
- CCTV to boost station security.



Early investigation work

Over the coming months you may notice Transport staff and contractors on site to identify utilities, geotechnical and environmental constraints, and other investigations to inform the strategic design.

Investigations will not be noisy and these investigations will have no impact to services or the community.

Community and stakeholder engagement

We are now focusing on early and meaningful consultation with key user and stakeholder groups to help plan and design the project around the community, resulting in better outcomes for our passengers.

We are engaging with various user groups to help inform the accessibility upgrades and concept design for Tascott Station. This includes hearing from people with a disability and their carers, women and parents from the local community to understand their perceptions of safety, and collaborative Connecting with Country events to recognise the unique relationship between Aboriginal people and their ancestral lands.

Transport will also be engaging with Central Coast Council and peak disability organisations.

We want to hear from people and carers with accessibility needs to better understand their experiences at train stations and how we could use those to improve our design for Tascott Station upgrade.
