


November community update

Tuggerah Station Upgrade

October 2024

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station. The upgrade will provide a train station that is safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers - especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who might be experiencing mobility problems.

Project status update

The new lifts and concourse will be open from late October, with facilities including the new public restrooms scheduled for early 2025.

What are we doing in November?

Work includes:

- general construction works, including delivery and removal of plant and materials
- adjustments to hoarding and fencing to facilitate construction works
- formwork, reinforcement and concrete pours
- crane movements to assist with construction
- earthwork activities including waste classification and removal of waste materials
- installation of utility connections for the station
- demolition of existing canopies
- demolition of existing ramps and pedestrian bridge
- demolition and excavation work and associated truck movements for import and export of materials.

We will use various items of equipment, including cranes, excavators, jack hammers, trucks including tipper, flat tray track and hiab, elevated work platform, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, powered and manual hand tools.

Drivers will continue to see construction vehicle movements and traffic control on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am** to **6pm Monday** to **Saturday.** We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Out of hours

From **6pm Friday 1 November** to **7am Monday 4 November 2024,** additional plant movements will occur in the Bryant Drive commuter car park during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed and trains will not be running.

There will also be additional movements on the Pacific Highway side of the station.

Machinery being used includes concrete saws and core drills, drills, demolition saws, lighting towers, heavy plant, flatbed tracks, and other powered hand tools.

This work will be conducted over the weekend to minimise disruption to the community when the station is less busy, however please be aware that there will be some noise and inconvenience.

Additionally, there will be no access through the station overpass during this period. Shuttle buses will be available to transport commuters between the Pacific Highway and Bryant Drive carpark, please follow the signage.

Changes to the commuter carpark

From **6am Friday 25 October** to **6.30pm Wednesday 6 November** a portion of the Bryant
Drive commuter car park will be temporarily closed.
Please see map below for further details.

To alleviate these impacts, there will be additional parking available at the Tuggerah Dog Park on



Second Avenue, with shuttle buses available during peak hours between 5am and 9am and 2:30pm and 6:30pm on Tuesday 29 October, Wednesday 30 October, Thursday 31 October and Tuesday 5 November to assist with transporting commuters to and from the train station. Signs will be in place to direct drivers.

The carpark area will be utilised as a lay down area for crane and structural steelwork preparation work in preparation for demolition of the old pedestrian footbridge.

Other temporary car parking changes will continue at Tuggerah Station to allow for construction work.

Managing our impacts

A traffic control team will be available to assist with any impacts to pedestrian movements.

This work may be noisy; however, we aim to avoid impacts to the community and the environment where possible by:

- fencing off areas for the safety of commuters
- using noise blankets and turning off machinery and equipment when not in use.
