Tuggerah Station Upgrade

March 2024

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station. The upgrade will provide a train station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What we are doing in March 2024?

Work includes:

- partial removal and demolition of existing canopies and entry stairs on Platform 1 and 2
- relocation of vending machines, ticketing machines and passenger information displays
- relocation of pedestrian station entrances, pathways and ramps for station access
- general construction works, including delivery and removal of plant and materials
- new undercover seating on Platform 2
- surveying and site investigations
- adjustments to hoardings and fencing to facilitate construction works
- formwork, reinforcement and concrete pours
- crane movements to assist with construction
- earthwork activities including waste classification and removal of waste materials
- relocation of lights, cameras and signs on both platforms
- completion of new structural supports under Platform 1
- installation of utility connections for the station.

Drivers will continue to see construction vehicle movements and traffic control on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road. During March, there will be continued temporary changes to car parking arrangements at Tuggerah Station to allow for construction work, this will include changes to disabled parking. Signage will be in place with further details.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am** to **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **7am** to **6pm Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Out of hours

From 10pm Friday 8 March until 4am Monday 11 March, additional plant movements will occur in the commuter carpark during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed and trains will not be running.

Work will include delivery and installation of precast planks for the new station structure, pad mount commissioning and the use of cranes, concrete trucks and heavy plant and powered hand tools.

There will be no pedestrian access over the bridge during these works. A shuttle bus will be provided for commuters and residents travelling between the Pacific Highway or Bryant Drive side of the tracks.

Upcoming changes to parking in the Bryant Drive commuter carpark

From **Friday 1 March** to **Tuesday 30 April** we will temporarily remove seven parking spots and six disabled parking spots from the commuter car park. Additional disabled parking spots are available in the council car park on Bryant Drive (see map below).

The area will be utilised as the lay down area for precast planks and structural steel for the new




pedestrian footbridge, prior to being lifted into final position.

Schedules and work are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

What will this mean for you?

We will use various equipment, including cranes, excavators, jack hammers, trucks including tipper, flat tray track and hiab, elevated work platform, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, powered and manual hand tools.

Managing our impacts

A traffic control team will be available to assist with any impacts to pedestrian movements.

This work may be noisy, however we aim to avoid impacts to the community and the environment where possible by:

- fencing off areas for the safety of commuters
- using noise blankets and turning off machinery and equipment when not in use.
