# Changes to parking to improve safety along Wall Park Avenue, Seven Hills

# Wall Park Avenue 'No Stopping' and Bus Stop changes from Monday 9 December

We thank the community for the Community involvement feedback received during the 'Have your Say' consultation in May-July 2023.

We listened to the community and resident feedback.

Transport has amended the project improving road safety for the community, all road users, improving public transport efficiency and traffic flow.

In May-June 2023, Transport invited community feedback on proposed changes to Wall Park Avenue through a 'Have Your Say', with late feedback accepted until July 2023.

Following this consultation, Transport received further feedback from the community and met with residents to listen to their concerns. Key feedback we heard from the community included:


- concerns about reduced safety for residents when exiting and entering their driveways.
- concerns about motorists speeding with the kerbside lanes free of parked cars, and
- concerns about loss of parking and changes to the way residents park their vehicles.

Transport thanks the community for their feedback.

Transport has considered all the feedback and will progress with an amended project that addresses the key concerns and prioritizes safety as well as retaining some more on-street parking. This is shown on the next page.

# What are the changes to the project?

The amended project includes the following changes to address key concerns:

- full time 'No Stopping' extended only to the intersections to meet minimum sight lines
- full time 'No Stopping' only at the vertical crest curve to meet minimum sight lines for drivers as well as residents exiting and entering their driveways
- full time 'No Stopping' extended at the school site to ensure safety at all times
- no change to the existing part-time and full-time 'No Stopping' zones opposite to the school. This will keep everyone safe near the school
- include right turn arrows at the existing right turn bays from Wall Park Avenue onto the side roads.

#### Parking on Wall Park Avenue

In Transport's original proposal there was no on-street parking, following the residents feedback the amended project scope has retained some on-street parking along Wall Park Avenue.

- 72 potential on-street parking spaces during the day peak hours, and
- 80 potential on-street parking spaces outside of school zone times.

### What happens next?

Following the completion of work, the 'No Stopping' zone will be in effect and vehicles will not be allowed to stop in these zones.

# Key benefits to the community



Improve safety for all road users and residents



 Reduce vehicle weaving due to parked vehicles on the road and improve view and line of sight at the vertical crest curve



 Provide better sight lines and visibility for residents exiting and entering their driveways near the crest



- Improve traffic capacity and flow at signalised intersections
- During the day there will be 72 potential on-street parking spaces, and



 Outside of school zone times there will be 80 potential on-street parking spaces



 Increase visibility when vehicles turn out of intersections and provide minimum length for left turn lanes.

# **Consultation Report**

Transport previously consulted with the community about this proposal in December 2018 and again in May 2023. A Consultation Report with Transport's responses to the feedback received was released for both consultations held.

## What work are we doing?

Our work will include:

- installing new 'No Stopping' signs
- replacing or removing existing 'No Stopping' signs
- removing two bus stop signs
- installing new bus zone signs

#### When and where we'll be working

We will be working along Wall Park Avenue for one day shift and one night shift between Monday 9 and Saturday 14 December, weather permitting.

Our day work hours are between 7am-5pm.

Our night work hours are between 8pm-6am.

You may notice vehicles and drilling equipment in the area as we complete this work.

Our work may be noisy at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible by using quieter equipment where possible and turning off vehicles and machines when not in use.

Access to driveways for residents will be maintained.

#### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours. Partial shoulder and lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place for the safety of our workers and motorists.

Motorists are advised to follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Transport thanks you for your patience as we complete this important work to improve road safety on this road.

### Mobile speed camera

To address concerns about the possibility of increased speeding on Wall Park Avenue, the community requested to have a speed camera on the road. We listened and Transport will implement a mobile speed camera on the road.

We will let you know when it is operational. The mobile speed camera will detect motorists going over the speed limit and serves as a reminder to drive to the speed limit.

There will be ongoing monitoring of Wall Park Avenue, including review of crashes, after these changes are put in place.

Transport also received feedback on the consultation process and will consider this feedback for future community consultations.
