Finishing work on the Waterfall Stabling Yard and Platform Extension project is currently being completed.

What work are we doing in Heathcote?

In early September 2024, we will be demobilising from our site compound at Heathcote Station. This work will involve:

- removing site sheds, materials and equipment from our site offices
- restoring the site to its original condition and handing back to Sydney Trains.
