The More Trains, More Services program is designed to simplify and modernise the rail network, delivering a range of benefits for rail customers through better infrastructure, new trains and extra services.

What work are we doing?

In February 2024, we will be completing the following work:

- removal of old track which will involve use of tamping machines and vibratory rollers
- construction of new, replacement track
- removal of old overhead wiring, signalling equipment and cable routes
- installation and testing of new signalling systems
- construction of a water tank and associated services
- extension of the northern end of the island platform.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours on this project are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am until 1pm on Saturday.

Work will be undertaken in and adjacent to the rail corridor at Waterfall, with some deliveries through the corridor access gate at Heathcote Station.

Weekend work

In February, some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours, between 6pm Friday 9 February and 7am Monday 12 February 2024.

This work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- · parking impacts inside the commuter car park
- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- intermittent use of the site access gate off Heathcote Station Commuter Cart Park
- deliveries of equipment and materials.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.



Temporary changes to commuter car parking



To support construction activities at Waterfall, we require temporary use of **30 commuter car spaces** from **5pm Tuesday 6 February to 5pm Wednesday 14 February 2024.**

We will also require an additional 20 car spaces from 5pm Friday 9 February to 5am Monday 12 February 2024.
