



Variable message sign installation on Waterfall Way from Monday 29 May 2023

Work to install variable message signs to provide information about road conditions will commence at various locations along Waterfall Way.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which involves installing six signs at locations between Bellingen and Armidale.

Work hours

Work will be carried out Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm, and Saturdays between 8am and 1pm. This work is expected to be complete in early June, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

This work will involve the use of machinery, which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use, positioning machinery away from residences and where possible starting noisy activities later in the morning.

Access to properties will be maintained. If this should change, affected residents will be notified.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of road users and workers.

Traffic control and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place for the duration of the work.

Single lane, alternating traffic flow arrangements will be in place during work hours at locations west of Bellingen and east of Armidale. Other locations will require shoulder closures only.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time while this traffic control is in place.

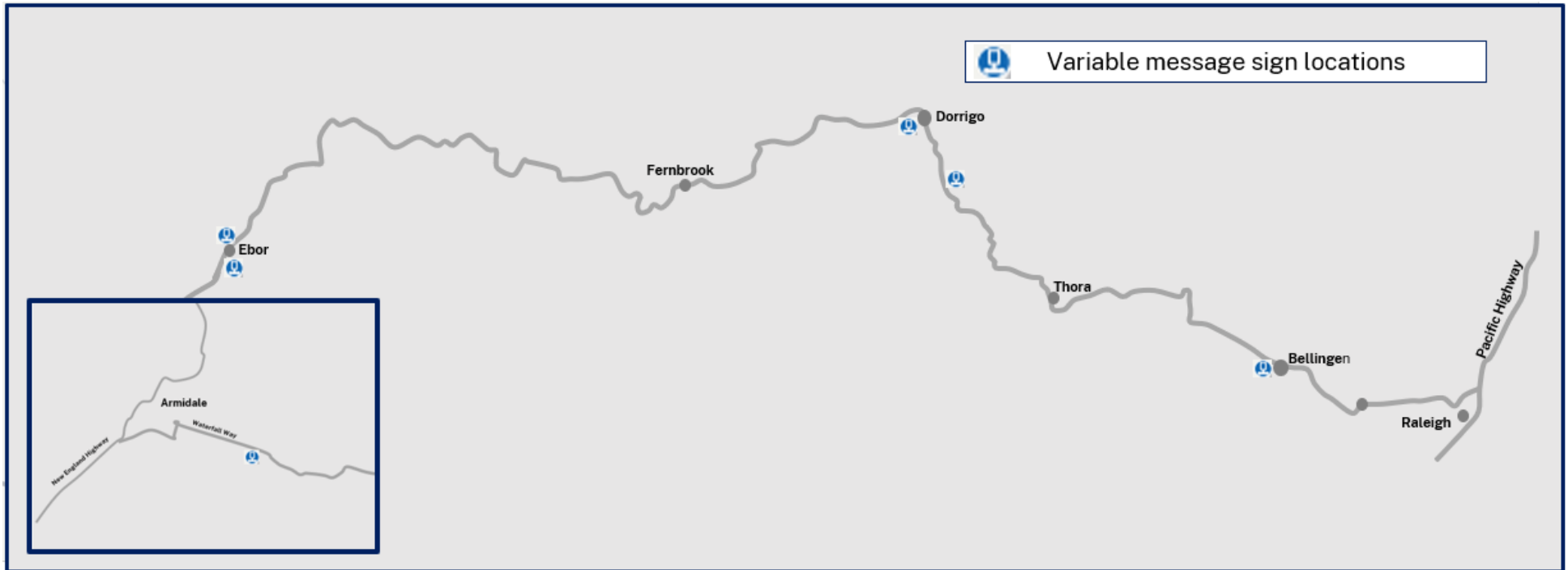
