


Installing new Speed signs on Great Western Highway, Warrimoo from Sunday 28 April 2024

Community Notification

April 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug Peoples of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is working to improve safety for all road users in the Blue Mountains.

We will install new speed limit signs at multiple points on and next to the Great Western Highway, Warrimoo, from Spurwood Road in the South to Green Parade in the North.

What work are we doing?

We will:

- remove existing speed limit signs and installing new ones at multiple points on and next to Great Western Highway, Warrimoo
- replace the existing Left Only sign and installing a new Give Way sign at the intersection of The Avenue and Great Western Highway, Warrimoo
- add new pavement numerals to support the new speed limit signs
- concreting new poles with signs

The speed limit will decrease from 50 to 40kmh near 14 Waratah Road, Warrimoo.

When will we be working?

We will be working for up to three night shifts between Sunday 28 April and Thursday 2 May, weather permitting.

Night work hours are from **8pm to 5am, Sunday** to **Thursday.**

We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights or on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- · Noise from machinery and equipment
- Plant moving in and out of the project site.

Please do not park on either side of the road where the work will be carried out, as this could affect property access.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. These measures include:

- reducing our noise as much as possible and turning off equipment when not in use
- using quieter equipment where possible
- safely escorting pedestrians through the work zone when necessary
- restoring and tidying the area once work is complete.

Traffic impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane closures, stop slow traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place for the safety of our workers and road users.
