

Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

Transport for NSW is building a new substation on Lusty Street in Wolli Creek to provide power supply for future rail services and allow us to decommission redundant services.

What work are we doing?

In June 2024 we will use hand tools and an elevated working platform to test an existing power cable inside the rail corridor on **Railway Street**, **Banksia**, between Godfrey Street and Knight Street.

Testing is required to ensure the cable can be integrated with the new electrical network once construction of the new substation in Wolli Creek has been completed. Testing will not impact power at residential premises.

When and where we'll be working

Testing of the power cable will occur between 6am and 6pm on Saturday 22 June and Sunday 23 June 2024.

The work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when the power cable can be safely disconnected. Please refer to the map overleaf for work location.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increased workers and vehicles in and near the work area
- noise from machinery and equipment.
