

# Upcoming work at Wollstonecraft Station between 15 July and 22 August

## Platform improvements

July 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cammeraygal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

On behalf of Sydney Trains, we will be carrying out some work to further improve accessibility and customer journeys at Wollstonecraft Station.

### What work are we doing?

Work involves raising the last 20 metres of Platform 2 to provide improved accessibility for passengers when getting on and off the train.

Work includes:

- concrete cutting on Platform 2
- installing piping and electrical cables
- replacing sections of the existing platform
- installing tactile ground surface indicators and platform painting.

### When and where we'll be working

For the safety of passengers and our team, most of our work will take place at night or over weekends during scheduled track maintenance, when the station is closed and the trains are not operating.

A full list of dates and times is outlined in the table over the page.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance, if we need to work at any other times.

### What will this mean for you?

We will use various equipment, including excavators, drills, concrete saws, generators, concrete vibrator machines, trucks, concrete pumps as well as powered and manual tools.

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Our work will not impact the train service timetable and the station will remain open to passengers except on the scheduled maintenance weekend Friday 26 to Monday 29 July.

**Any residents directly impacted by noisy work will be individually contacted via letter prior to the activity starting.**

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

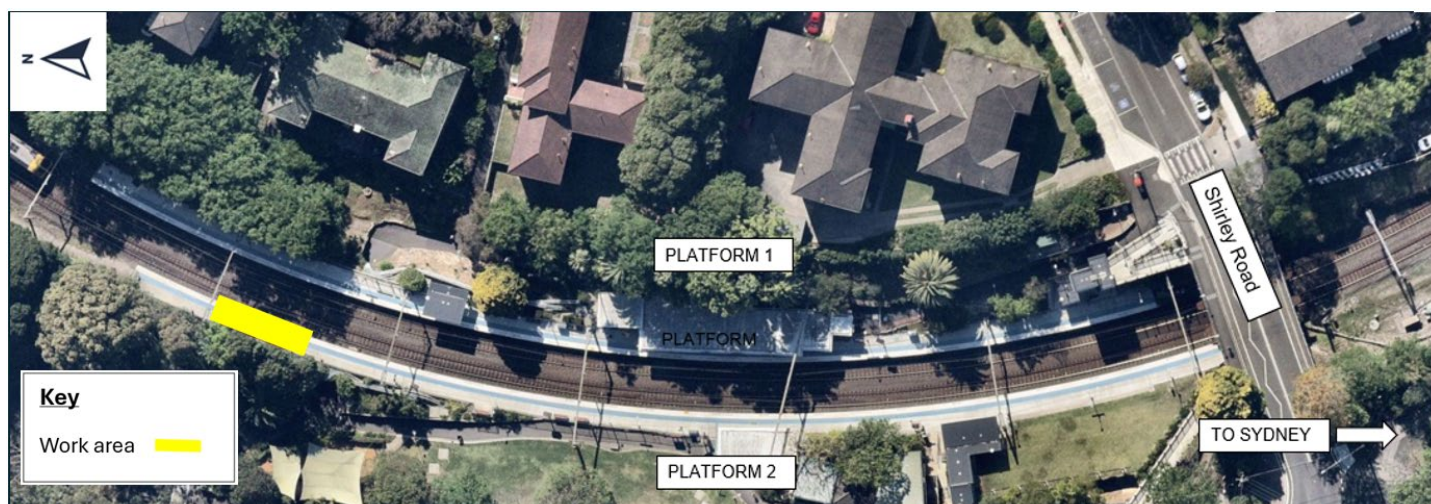
- fencing the area for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible and by turning off equipment when not in use
- targeting lighting to minimise light spill.
