

'No Stopping' zones extended on Woodstock Avenue, Plumpton from 24 June

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is extending the 'No Stopping' zones between Duke Street and the M7 along Woodstock Avenue, Plumpton to improve safety for residents and road users, and create more reliable travel times.

Transport had a proposal to extend the 'No Stopping' zones between Duke Street and the M7 on Woodstock Avenue, Plumpton. The proposal was to provide better sight lines for residents exiting their driveways, to reduce vehicle weaving movements due to parked vehicles and improve traffic flow and reduce congestion.

On 6 March 2024, we distributed 1,200 community notifications to residents and businesses inviting feedback on the proposal to extend the 'No Stopping' zones.

The Have Your Say consultation period was from 6 March to 5 April 2024, with late submissions accepted until 6 April. Comments were invited via online survey, email, post and phone.

What have we learned?

Transport received 145 submissions during the consultation period, all of which were from the general community and local businesses. There was majority support for the proposed 'No Stopping' zones extension.

Submissions relate to:

- safety
- parking
- congestion
- alternative options and future work.

The feedback has helped us better understand how the local community uses Woodstock Avenue.

Transport has made the decision to progress with the original proposal.

Key benefits to the community

- improve safety for road users and residents by reducing vehicle weaving movements due to parked vehicles
- easier access and better sight lines for residents using their driveways and for pedestrians crossing the road
- improve traffic flow and reduce congestion by efficiently using all existing lanes, resulting in more reliable travel times

What happens next?

Work to install the 'No Stopping' signs will begin on **24 June**, weather permitting. We will be on site for two night shifts between **24 and 30 June 2024**. Our night work hours are **8pm to 5am**.

Following the completion of work, the 'No Stopping' zone will be in effect and vehicles will not be allowed to stop in these zones.



How will this affect you?

There may be noisy work at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance to residents and local business where possible.

Traffic changes

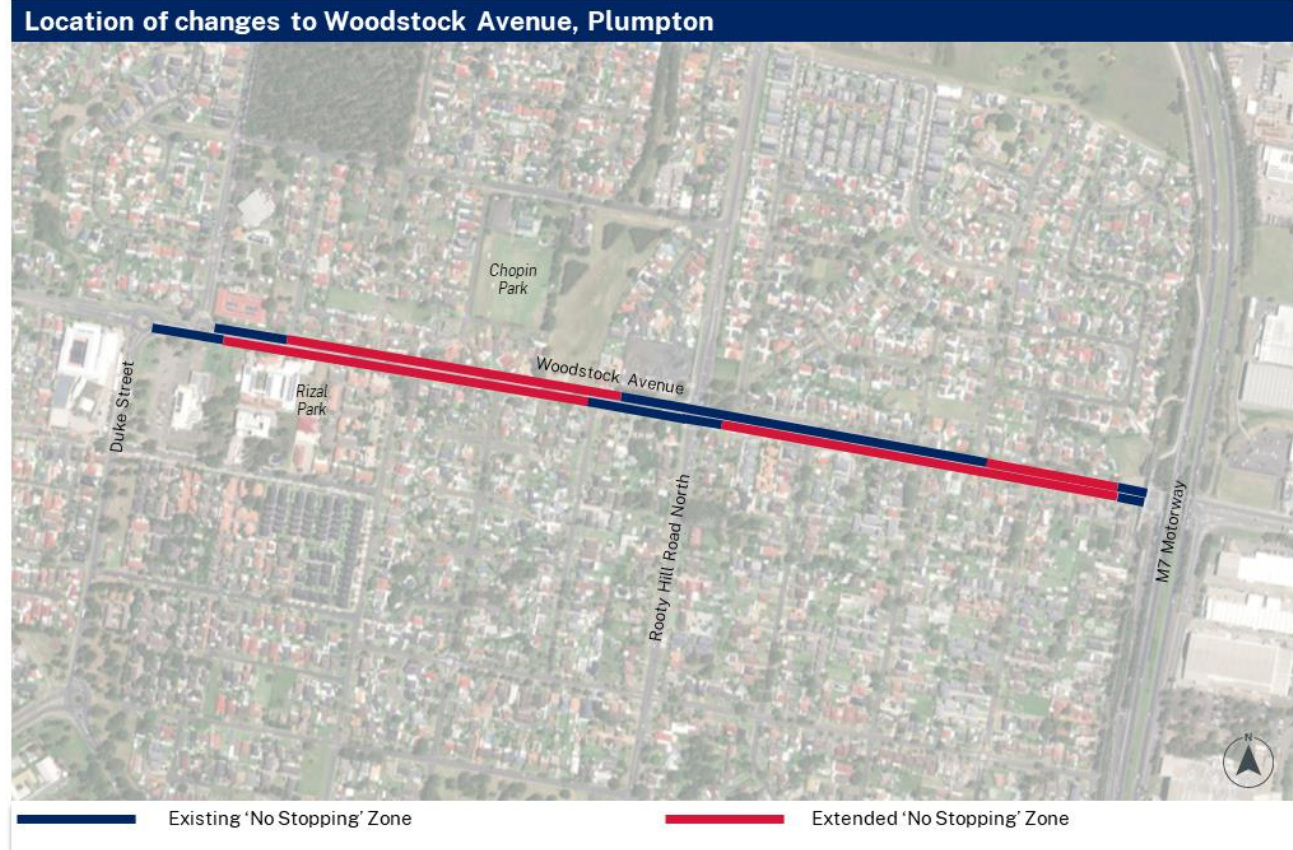
There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit
