



# Safety improvement work commencing at the intersection of Woodville Road and Guildford Road, Guildford from Sunday 7 April 2024

## Community Notification

March 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is improving traffic flow and pedestrian safety at the intersection of Woodville Road and Guildford Road, Guildford. Work will commence on Sunday 7 April and is expected to be completed by Friday 24 May 2024.

### What work are we doing?

To improve road safety, traffic flow and travel times, right turn green arrows will be installed at the intersection for Guildford Road motorists turning right into Woodville Road in both directions.

Pedestrian safety will also be improved by the installation of new red arrows which will allow pedestrians to cross the intersection safely while holding motorists on red arrows.

Work activities will include:

- installing new traffic signal infrastructure, including traffic light cabling, within the footpath and road area
- installing new lanterns onto the existing traffic light poles at the intersection
- trimming back the concrete median on Woodville Road to improve turning movements from Guildford Road.

### When will we be working?

We will be on site for up to **13 night shifts** between **Sunday 7 April** and **Friday 24 May 2024**, weather permitting.

We will work from **Sunday to Thursday**, between **8pm** and **5am** the next day.

We will not work on Friday nights, Saturdays or public holidays.

We will work up to five nights a week to complete the work as quickly as possible and to minimise the impact to the community.

### What will this mean for you and how will we manage it?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to limit disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians and motorists. It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use
- completing the noisier tasks by midnight
- installing noise blankets around our work when carrying out noisier activities, such as jackhammering
- using quieter equipment where possible.

### Traffic and pedestrian changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to make sure the work zone is safe for our workers and road users. This will include lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Temporary traffic lights will also be used while we are installing the new lanterns.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Access to pedestrian crossings at the intersection will be maintained at all times under the guidance of traffic controllers.
