

# **Sydenham Control Centre Project**

## **Digital Systems Program**

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is rolling out new technology to upgrade Sydney's rail network and introducing modern signalling as part of the Digital Systems Program.

The Program will replace current signalling and train control technology with modern, internationally proven, intelligent systems. It will help improve reliability and increase capacity on Sydney's railways once implemented widely across the network.

The Sydenham Control Centre Project is one of several projects which form part of the Digital Systems Program.

#### What work are we doing?

Work through April 2024 will be focused on upgrading signalling and power at the Sydenham Control Centre. Activities to complete this work will include:

- delivering plant and materials to and from the site
- signalling and electrical works
- connecting a diesel generator at Sydenham Control Centre to provide a temporary power supply
- · testing and commissioning activities
- restoring locations upon completion of work.

#### Equipment to be used

Plant and equipment expected to be used include service and delivery vehicles, powered hand tools, and generators.

### When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday. The work location is shown on the map on the next page, located near the Fraser Park Football Club.

For the safety of workers, there is some night work scheduled from Thursday 11 April through to the morning of Friday 12 April. Both day and night work will also be carried out from Saturday 13 April through to the morning of Monday 15 April.

If weather or site conditions impact this planned work, it may be delayed to a later date.

#### What will this mean for you?

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising the impact on the community. You may notice an increase in construction vehicle movements within and near the rail corridor work areas.

#### Managing our impacts

There will be no impact to access or operation of the Fraser Park Football Club.

We switch off equipment when it is not being used and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. Where noise outside standard construction hours is expected to impact residents, they will be notified directly.
