Road work on Canterbury Road, from Campsie to Canterbury

March 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government will be carrying out road resurfacing work on Canterbury Road, from Campsie to Canterbury, as part of a major maintenance program to provide smoother and safer road surfaces with consistent driving conditions.

What work are we doing?

Work will involve replacing failed concrete slabs and resurfacing deteriorated sections along Canterbury Road, commencing at Bexley Road and moving towards Cooks River. Please see detailed map overleaf.

Equipment used will include a profiler, excavator, bobcat sweeper, concrete mixer, and a suction vacuum truck.

Our work schedule

Our work hours will be between **8pm and 5am** to minimise traffic disruption and maintain safety for workers and motorists.

We will be working along Canterbury Road for up to **45 night shifts** between **Sunday 3 March** and **Sunday 23 June 2024**, for up to five nights in a row.

No work will be done on Saturday nights or public holidays. All work is subject to site and weather conditions and dates may change.

Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times. We have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and positioning equipment away from homes and businesses and completing noisier tasks by midnight where possible.

During this work some parking may be impacted for short periods. We will advise residents of upcoming parking changes prior to work. If you regularly park along these roads please join our mailing list to receive email updates.

Changes to traffic conditions

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure work zones are safe throughout works:

- Partial lane closures will be in place at times along construction zones and may affect travel times.
- Bus stops may be temporarily impacted. Please follow guidance from traffic controllers onsite.
- We will ensure access to properties in and near the work zone are maintained as much as possible.
- Mobile electronic message signs will provide advanced warning on any traffic changes throughout works.

Please adhere to any speed limits and follow the direction of assigned traffic controllers and signage.
