


Work continuing at Coxs River Road from August 2024

Coxs River Road Upgrade

August 2024







Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Earthworks and construction activities will continue across the site over the **next six to eight weeks** including:

- general earthworks
- installing drainage
- asphalting
- constructing property accesses
- installing lane markers, traffic domes, safety barriers, signage, and line marking
- landscaping
- finalising retaining walls
- kerbing and general concrete works
- spray sealing.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working along Coxs River Road, Baaners Lane and on the southern side of the Great Western Highway within the project limits.

We will continue working under our standard working hours between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.**

If we need to work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you may notice:

- noise from machinery and equipment
- plant movement in and out of the project site.


Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing work areas for safety and security
- using watercarts daily to help control dust
- reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use
- monitoring and maintaining our environmental controls during and after high rainfall events.
