

Night work on Hexham Bridge, Hexham from Tuesday 2 April

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance to ensure the safe and reliable operation of Hexham Bridge.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out bi-annual maintenance work on the bridge, which includes inspecting, testing, and servicing the lift span systems, as well as general routine bridge maintenance.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Hexham Bridge from **Tuesday 2 April** for **two weeks**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday**.

What will this mean for you?

The work involves the use of machinery which generates noise.

You may notice:

- · Workers and vehicles
- A 40km/h speed limit during work hours
- The southbound bridge will be closed during the work and traffic will be directed onto the northbound bridge, which will operate with one lane in each direction
- The opening span will not open to marine traffic during the work

- The pedestrian footpath will be closed during the work and traffic control will safely escort pedestrians across the bridge
- As part of barrier installation work for the Hexham Straight Widening project, lane width reductions will be in place at the northbound intersection onto Maitland Road and the southern side of the bridge at the intersection of Maitland Road.

Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time during this work.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible and carrying out the noisiest activities by 11pm.
