



Night work on Hexham Bridge, Hexham from Monday 2 September

August 2024

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of Hexham Bridge.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out bi-annual maintenance work on the bridge, which includes inspecting, testing, and servicing the lift span systems, as well as general routine bridge maintenance.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Hexham Bridge from **Monday 2 September** for **two nights**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **8.30pm to 4am, Monday to Tuesday**.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles.
- Traffic controllers and signage.
- Southbound bridge closure during the work. All traffic will be directed onto the northbound bridge, which will operate with one lane in each direction.
- The opening span will not open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.
- The pedestrian footpath will be closed while the work is carried out.

- Traffic control will be on site to safely escort pedestrians across the bridge while the footpath is closed.
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- A 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time during this work.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Noisiest work to be completed by 11pm.
