Princes Highway and Hawken Road intersection safety improvements

Princes Highway upgrade October 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

As planning continues for the Princes Highway upgrade – Jervis Bay Road to Hawken Road, Transport for NSW is improving safety at the Hawken Road and Princes Highway intersection.

Safety works have commenced with new asphalt and line-marking applied at the Hawken Road and Blackbutt Range Road intersections to improve the safe operation of these sections of the highway.

A thermoplastic layer of line-marking is still required to be carried out and this work is expected to be done in the coming weeks, weather permitting.

The safety improvements include:

- Simplifying the Hawken Road intersection by providing a left turn bay for southbound traffic, removing the southbound merge and reducing the overtaking length on the highway.
- A dedicated right turn bay into Hawken Road for northbound traffic to reduce the risk of rear-end accidents.
- Moving the give way hold line further out at the intersection to improve line of sight.
- A right turn treatment at Blackbutt Range Road to provide space for a through vehicle to pass a right turning vehicle.
