Princes Highway Upgrade Program

Construction Update

March 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments are delivering an upgrade to the Princes Highway and Jervis Bay Road intersection at Falls Creek.

What work are we doing?

During March and April, work will continue within the project area including:

- installation of safety barriers
- vegetation clearing
- utility, geotechnical and survey investigations
- removal of existing fencing and installation of new boundary fencing
- relocation of existing utilities, including water, electrical and telecommunications
- construction of a temporary u-turn bay and a local driveway access road from the Princes Highway.

When we'll be working

Day work will be carried out from Monday 18 March, and night work on selected dates from **Monday 25 March until Tuesday 30 April 2024** (excluding the Easter period between Friday 29 March and Monday 1 April).

There will be no impacts to traffic between the hours of 6am and 6pm during the school holiday period between Friday 12 April and Sunday 28 April.

Standard day work hours are Monday to Friday, between 7am and 6pm and on Saturdays between 8am and 1pm.

Night work will be carried out for up to **17 shifts** between **Monday 25 March** and **Tuesday 30 April 2024**. Night work hours will be between 6pm and 7am. All work is subject to weather conditions. We will keep the community informed of any changes.

Temporary traffic changes

During the work, there will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work area is safe. Partial lane/shoulder closures and reduced speed limits of 40 km/h may be in place on the Princes Highway and Jervis Bay Road.

Motorists are advised to drive to conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control. During night work, motorists should allow an extra five minutes' travel time.

What will this mean for you?

Some activities need to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to our workers and road users. We will not work more than two consecutive nights in the same area. Our work may be noisy at times, however we will do everything we can to minimise these impacts including using non-tonal reversing beepers on equipment, turning machinery off when not in use and carrying out noisier works early during the night shift.



Managing the impacts of land clearing

Vegetation clearing on site will be staged and will continue over the coming months. The map below shows the area to be cleared.

We understand the clearing of trees and vegetation around the site will create a visible impact, however the site must be cleared to allow for the intersection to be upgraded. We would like to reassure the community that we follow all regulations as outlined in the Review of Environmental Factors to manage the environmental impacts.
