



Road closure on Jenolan Caves Road at Hampton

Jenolan Caves Road – Hampton slope repair

January 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is funding the repair of Jenolan Caves Road at Hampton

Lead contractor, McIlwain will be undertaking essential work on behalf of Transport for NSW to prepare the site for the commencement of the remediation of the Hampton Slope.

The works will commence from the 16 January and the entire project is expected to be completed by September 2024, weather permitting.

To safely enable the work, a number of full road closures at the site will be required.

We will provide a monthly update on works and closure dates as the project progresses.

What work are we doing?

During January, we are carrying out essential vegetation removal work which requires the road to be closed.

The terrain around the Hampton slope is very challenging and in order to provide safe access and remediate the slope failure, approximately 20 trees and vegetation will need to be removed.

When and where we'll be working

To facilitate the work, a series of closures of Jenolan Caves Road at Hampton will be required for the safety of motorists and workers.

During each closure **Jenolan Caves Road will be closed at Hampton** between Old Bindo Road and Duckmaloi Road **from 7am to 5pm**.

The closure dates for January are:

- Tuesday 16 January 2024
- Wednesday 17 January 2024
- Thursday 18 January 2024
- Friday 19 January 2024
- Monday 22 January 2024
- Wednesday 24 January 2024
- Monday 29 January 2024
- Tuesday 30 January 2024

What will this mean for you?

A detour will be in place during this work. We have included a map to show the alternate route.

The detour will be via Oberon, Bathurst and Lithgow using Duckmaloi Road, O'Connell Road and the Great Western Highway in both directions.

The detour will add approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes additional travel time.

For people travelling to Oberon from the Blue Mountains, this will add approximately 30 minutes travel time.

Traffic control and reduced speed limits will also be in place after work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should plan ahead and allow extra travel time during this work.

We understand that this work may generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.
