



Mascot Station Access Upgrade

Escalator Closure

April 2024

Access at Mascot Station is being upgraded to enable a better flow for customers and support more services for the T8 Airport Line.

Between **Wednesday 17 and Wednesday 24 April**, the escalators on the western side of Mascot Station will be closed on weeknights, between **9pm and 5am**. The lift will remain open and access at the eastern entrance on Bourke Street will not be impacted during this time.

What work are we doing?

This closure will enable the project team to make some adjustments to the escalator steps, wiring, emergency systems and glass barriers.



When and where we'll be working

Night work will take place inside the station between **9pm and 5am** on:

- **Wednesday 17 April**
- **Thursday 18 April**
- **Friday 19 April**
- **Monday 22 April**
- **Tuesday 23 April**

What does this mean for you?

You may notice some noise during this period and every effort will be made to minimise impacts, including closing the door to the western station entrance to contain noise inside the station.

Station access on the western side will be available via the lift and the eastern entrance on Bourke Street will not be impacted.
