# **Medlow Bath Upgrade**

August 2024







Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Great Western Highway from south of Bellevue Crescent to Station Street, and on Railway Parade.

## What work are we doing?

Construction activities will occur over the **next eight weeks** including:

- general earthworks, pavement, drainage and utility work
- installing line marking, signage and street lighting
- relocating traffic barriers and installing traffic controls
- station access work, constructing pedestrian footpaths, fencing and the kiss and ride area
- stormwater adjustment, utility work, verge earthworks, sediment basin construction, reinstating the road and landscaping
- constructing the pedestrian bridge, stairs, lifts and station services.

## What this will mean for you

We will be temporarily relocating bus stops on the Highway, within 100m of their existing locations. This may occur at various time to facilitate construction work.

We are also preparing for an upcoming traffic switch that will shift traffic onto the newly constructed eastbound lanes to allow for construction of the westbound lanes.

# When and where we'll be working

Day work hours are from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 4pm.

Nightwork will continue for utilities and stormwater works.

Nightwork hours will be between **6pm and 7am**, **Monday to Friday** for no more than two nights in a row, and no more than three nights in a week.

Affected residents will be notified about any upcoming nightwork dates.

## Managing our impacts


We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- maintaining access to properties at all times
- maintaining pedestrian access
- turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages to minimise impacts to nearby residents
- installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible
- speaking with directly affected residents.

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h in some areas.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
