

Weekend work on pedestrian bridge 31 August and 1 September

Medlow Bath Upgrade

August 2024







Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Construction is progressing on the new pedestrian bridge at Medlow Bath Station.

We are timing our next stage of work to align with a planned Sydney Trains possession weekend on Saturday 31 August and Sunday 1 September.

No train services will operate during this time.

What work we are doing

Work on the station platform will include:

- resurfacing the platform
- installing temporary bridge supports
- installing light poles on station stairs
- continuing work on lift one, including lowering canopies and installing downpipes
- electrical work across the platform
- forming the embankment along Railway Parade.

When and where we'll be working

Work will align with the Sydney Trains rail possession from 12:01am Saturday 31 August to 2:00am Monday 2 September.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work activities.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- an increase in plant, vehicle and truck movements in the area
- work activity on the railway platform and surrounding areas
- signage and traffic impacts along Railway Parade.

Pedestrian access will be maintained along Railway Parade to Medlow Park, Potbelly Café and Medlow Bath Station. Please follow signage and the marked path for your safety.


Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- providing a pedestrian pathway along Railway Parade
- turning off machinery when not in use
- always maintaining access to properties
- liaising directly with affected residents and businesses prior to work commencing
- arranging work in stages at different locations
- traffic control to maintain and direct vehicle movements.

Traffic Impacts

As required, traffic management will be in place along Railway Parade throughout the rail possession.

Traffic control and signage will be in place, including a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Road users, including pedestrians and school children, are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control. For traffic updates, call 132 701, download the Live Traffic NSW App or visit livetraffic.com.
