## Regional Rail – Mindyarra Maintenance Centre

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

### We are replacing the ageing NSW regional rail fleet of XPT, XPLOER and Endeavour trains.

The new trains will provide new safety features, improved accessibility facilities and reliability for customers who travel from many NSW regional centres to Sydney, as well as Canberra, Melbourne and Brisbane.

To support the new fleet, a purpose-built maintenance centre has been built in Dubbo.

Momentum Trains is delivering the Regional Rail Project on behalf of Transport for NSW.

### What has been happening?

We have recently completed building the new Mindyarra Maintenance Centre located off Wingewarra Street, Dubbo.

The centre is now being operated by UGL Pty Limited who is part of the Momentum Trains consortium.

The first two trains of the Regional Rail fleet have arrived and will gradually be moved to Auburn in preparation for dynamic testing on the Sydney Trains network.

Meanwhile, as more trains arrive in Dubbo, a local specialist team will carry out train fit-out and completion work at the maintenance centre.

### What work will be happening?

Train completion works and ongoing maintenance activities, have started on site.

### What will this mean for you?

Mindyarra Maintenance Centre will operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The centre will continue to receive the new Regional Rail trains and perform the required tests to ensure they are operationally ready for passenger service.

### Managing our impacts

During operation any noisy activities will be scheduled during the day, where possible.

These types of activities may include but are not limited to use of power and hand tools, deliveries in and out of the site by road and rail, train horns, and truck and light vehicle movements.

### More information

Working closely with the local community is a priority for Transport for NSW and Momentum Trains. We will keep you up to date about any upcoming work.
