

Night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road on 25 March, 2 and 3 April 2024 and traffic changes in April school holidays

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

Night work is scheduled on 25 March, 2 and 3 April 2024.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Utility crossing and relocation work
- Drainage work
- Surveying on the M4 Motorway
- Utility cutovers
- Restoring the site when work is finished.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 Motorway ramps (see map overleaf).

Working hours are 6pm to 7am on:

- Monday 25 March, 2 and 3 April 2024.
- In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Tuesday 26 and Wednesday 27 March 2024.

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, plate compactors, tipper trucks, a concrete agitator, concrete vibrators, vacuum trucks, excavators, and other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment.

Our schedule of work

- Drainage work along Mulgoa Road
- Installing intelligent transport systems

- on the M4 ramps
- Utility crossing near Wolseley Street and on Mulgoa Road
- Utility investigation and work along Mulgoa Road, M4 ramps and side streets
- Utility cutovers
- Surveying the M4 ramps.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawkers from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite. These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

Traffic changes during night work

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, there will be traffic controllers to guide drivers.


Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Traffic changes during April school holidays – closure of M4 westbound and eastbound off ramps

The ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road both east and westbound will be closed during night work on the **15 and 16 April from 8pm to 6am**.

These ramps and the kerbside lanes on Mulgoa Road will be closed during the daytime on 17, 18 and 19 April 2024 from 9am to 3pm.
