Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work on the Golden Highway in Dubbo.

What work are we doing?

The work will include asphalting to repair the damaged road surface on Cobbora Road between the King Street intersection and the White Street intersection.

We have included a map to show the location of the work area.

When we'll be working

We will be working between **7pm** and **5am Sunday to Friday**, from **Sunday 28 July**.

We expect to complete the work in **three shifts**. All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

What will this mean for you?

There may be temporary impacts to vehicle and pedestrian access while the work is carried out.

Please ensure vehicles are parked off-street prior to the commencement of work at 7pm each night for the three-night duration of the works.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

The road will remain open with single lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit in place during work hours which may affect travel times.

The speed limit will return to the posted speed limit outside of work hours.

Motorists should allow up to **five minutes** extra travel time.

There may also be local road detours in place for White Street and Mary MacKillop Avenue during these work hours. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
