## **Priority pavement repair work** May 2022

## Transport for NSW is carrying out priority pavement repairs in your area from 24 May 2022.

Due to recent wet weather events experienced across Sydney, Transport for NSW has identified a number of road locations requiring urgent pavement repairs. The majority of this work will involve replacing sections of asphalt where there are significant defects such as potholes, cracking, or uneven road surfaces.

This work will improve road safety by providing a smoother road surface, and consistent driving conditions.

## Transport for NSW have identified a pavement defect near your property. We will be carrying out these repairs between 24 May and 31 July 2022.

Most of the maintenance work will take place at night, but some work will take place during the day, where safe to do so. The majority of this work, depending on the size of the area, will take **between 0.5 to 2 shifts to complete**.

Our **night work hours** will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our **day work hours** will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**. We will not work on public holidays.

We will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts, including using quieter equipment where we can, turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use and completing the noisier tasks, such as removal of existing asphalt earlier in the evening.
