



# Intermittent closures of Scabbing Flat Bridge

September 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Scabbing Flat Bridge will be closed intermittently throughout September and October for essential safety maintenance and repair work.

## What work are we doing?

We will be replacing girders and corbels on both approaches to the bridge, which requires temporary closures to all traffic.

## When we'll be working

Work will take place **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 5pm**. **The bridge will be closed between 9am and 3pm** on the following dates:

- 17 - 19 September 2024
- 1 - 3 October 2024
- 15 - 17 October 2024
- 29 - 31 October 2024

## What will this mean for you?

During the closure times, all vehicles must follow the detour routes listed below. Please note that additional closures may be required for ongoing repairs, and we will notify you in advance.

## Detour routes

### Detour via Wellington:

- Allow up to 25 minutes of extra travel time
- Detour via Renshaw McGirr Way/Suntop Road/Arthurville Road.

### Detour via Dubbo:

- Allow up to 45 minutes of extra travel time
- Detour via Obley Road/Benolong Road/Terrabella Road/Arthurville Road.

**Please note that Scabbing Flat Bridge continues to have a 16-tonne load limit in place and heavy vehicles will need to use the detour routes at all times.**

We encourage all motorists to allow for additional travel time depending on your destination. A detailed map of the detour routes is included over the page for your reference.
