Spring Farm Parkway is a key eastwest link that will support the Greater Macarthur region, meeting the needs of a growing population by connecting communities.

In this final project update, you will see our upcoming work activities, work schedule and any traffic changes for the months of January and February.

We sincerely thank the community for their patience, understanding, and support during the construction of this important project.

What's happening next?

The final stage of work will include:

- demobilising the site compound
- removal of stockpile sites
- · minor defect work
- landscaping across the project
- road maintenance

Our work schedule

During the months of January and February, our standard work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturdays.**

Unless otherwise notified, our night work construction hours are from **6pm to 5am**, **Sunday to Thursday** with no more than five consecutive nights of work at one time.

These hours exclude public holidays and inclement weather.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts on the community and the environment. Our work may be noisy at times and we apologise for any inconvenience.

Where possible we minimise noise by:

- · turning off machinery when not in use
- positioning equipment such as generators away from properties
- undertaking noise monitoring
- communicating over radio and hand signals

What will this mean for you?

During our work hours, we may use noisy machinery and equipment. You may notice:

- workers, vehicles, traffic controllers and signage
- road/lane closures, detours, and reduced speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment

Traffic changes

To minimise traffic disruptions and safety risks to workers and road users, reduced speed limits have been implemented around our work area.

These include:

- 40km/h or 60km/h speed limit on Spring Farm Parkway while work is being carried out near live traffic
- 40km/h or 60km/h speed limit on Menangle Road while work is being carried out near live traffic
- 40km/h on the Hume Motorway during night

Electronic signage will advise road users of these changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller's directions.


