# Start of work on Swansea Bridge, Swansea from Monday 24 June

The NSW Government is funding maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of Swansea bridge.

## What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes inspections, cleaning and brace installation on the some of the bridge piers.

### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working from **Monday 24 June** and expect to complete the work intermittently over **two weeks**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7am** to **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**, weather permitting.

Work will be carried out from under the bridge.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

#### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Periodic openings of the bridge
- Expected delay of up to 10 minutes during required openings.

The public access car park on the north-east side of the bridge will be closed during work hours for safety. Alternative un-timed car parks are available on the southern side of the bridge.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

#### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

We will minimise impact by:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- No opening will be done during peak road traffic times at 8am and 4pm.
