



Start of work on Swansea Bridge, Swansea from Sunday 20 October

The NSW Government is funding essential biannual maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes survey work, inspecting and testing the electrical, mechanical and hydraulic components and the emergency systems of the bridge. We will also be carrying out maintenance work to the bridge hydraulic locks and pumps.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working from **Sunday 20 October** and expect to complete the work in ten shifts over **two weeks**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7pm to 5am** from **Sunday to Thursday**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- One bridge will remain open at all times, operating with one lane in each direction
- A reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

The bridge will not be open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

We will minimise impact by:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Turning off machinery when not in use.
