


# Terania Street reopened to light vehicles

## The NSW Government is reopening Terania Street to light vehicles.

#### What is happening?

Transport for NSW (Transport) is pleased to inform the Lismore community that Terania Street is now opened to light vehicles.

We thank the community for your patience during the closure and construction of the temporary safety treatments.

#### Temporary restrictions

The temporary safety treatment such as raised traffic islands will enforce the restriction of heavy vehicles over 4.5 tonne gross vehicle mass (GVM) from entering the restricted road approaching the rail bridge on Terania St.

Given the high risk of further strikes destabilising the bridge, it is critical that we restrict heavy vehicles to prevent further strikes.

The 'No Right Turn' restrictions turning into and out of Peate Street means that vehicles entering Peate Street from Terania Street or exiting Peate Street to travel westbound would need to detour via Pine, Crane and Tweed streets.

A surveillance camera will be in place to monitor vehicle compliance with these new restrictions.

These restrictions are temporary, while Transport continues to prioritise the process relating to the removal of the rail bridge.

#### Removal of the bridge

Transport received approval from NSW Heritage Council to remove Terania Street rail bridge and is working through the heritage approval consent conditions along with other environmental approvals and the demolition plan to enable works to proceed.

Transport will continue to prioritise the legislative processes required for the removal of the rail bridge. This process is expected to take up to three months to be finalised and approved.

We will keep the community informed of progress including start of site work in due course.


#### Heavy vehicle detour
