Tuggerah Station Upgrade

August 2024

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station. The upgrade will provide a train station that is safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers - especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who might be experiencing mobility problems.

Project status update

Please note that new lifts and concourse are currently scheduled to be open to the public towards the end of the year, with all facilities including the new public restrooms scheduled for February 2025.

Remaining finishing work is to be completed by June 2025. We will continue to keep the community informed as the project progresses.

What are we doing in September?

Work includes:

- general construction works, including delivery and removal of plant and materials
- adjustments to hoarding and fencing to facilitate construction works
- formwork, reinforcement and concrete pours
- crane movements to assist with construction
- earthwork activities including waste classification and removal of waste materials
- installation of utility connections for the station
- demolition and excavation work and associated truck movements for import and export of materials.

We will use various items of equipment, including cranes, excavators, jack hammers, trucks including tipper, flat tray truck and hiab, elevated work platform, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, powered and manual hand tools.

Drivers will continue to see construction vehicle movements and traffic control on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Changes to the commuter carpark

During September, there will be continued temporary changes to car parking arrangements at Tuggerah Station to allow for construction work.

We will be temporarily removing twelve parking spots and six accessible parking spots from the commuter car park on Bryant Drive.

Additional accessible parking spots are available in the adjacent council car park. Signage is in place to direct drivers.

The area will be utilised for a lay down area for structural steelwork preparation work between and the ramp demolition later this year.

Changes to Kiss & Ride

There will be reduced parking at the Kiss & Ride drop off area in September to facilitate deliveries and construction work Bryant Drive side.



Managing our impacts

A traffic control team will be available to assist with any impacts to pedestrian movements as and when required.

This work may be noisy, however we aim to avoid impacts to the community and the environment where possible by:

- fencing off areas for the safety of commuters
- using noise blankets and turning off machinery and equipment when not in use.
