



# Turrella Station Upgrade Community Update

## Transport Access Program

February 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Dharug and Eora Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Turrella Station Upgrades is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and passengers with luggage.

### What are we doing?

Work includes:

- footpath and balustrade work to continue on Reede Street bridge and Turrella Street
- installing cladding on the new station entrance structure and platform canopy
- fit-out of station lift
- landscaping along Turrella Street.

The above work involves the delivery and removal of construction material and equipment, as well as the use of heavy equipment such as concrete trucks, elevated working platforms and excavators. Traffic and pedestrian detours will be in place during the work.

### Out of hours work

Work to remove the station electrical transformer is planned to occur from **6pm to 7am on Monday 19 to Friday 23 February 2024**. Impacted residents will be contacted individually. Schedules and work are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

### Extended Saturday hours

For the month of February, our construction hours will be between **8am and 6pm on Saturdays**. These extended hours will allow us to complete the upgrade and finalise installation of the lifts.

### Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

For the remainder of the project, one lane of Reede Street bridge will continue to be closed intermittently during construction hours, for the set-up of equipment and to carry out work on the station platform, footpath and station entry. Traffic control will be in place during the closures.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management. Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel time during this period.
