

New Bus Lane Camera system on Victoria Road (citybound), Rozelle

August 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will install a new bus lane camera system on Victoria Road (citybound) between Hartley and Robert streets, Rozelle.

We have introduced a citybound offset bus lane on Victoria Road through Rozelle to improve bus reliability and efficiency.

Buses, taxis, hire cars, bicycles and motorcycles can use a bus lane. Other vehicles can drive in a bus lane for a maximum of 100 metres if they are entering or leaving the road or to avoid an obstruction.

The bus lane camera system helps bus passengers reach their destination on time by monitoring usage of the bus lane. If you drive a private vehicle in a bus lane zone for more than 100 metres, the details may be recorded by a bus lane camera and the registered vehicle owner may receive a penalty notice.

What work are we doing?

Our work will involve installing camera poles and signage at three locations, plus:

- setting up environmental controls,
- installing temporary barriers and devices,
- installing roadside cabinets,
- saw cutting sensors in the roadway,
- road trenching,
- cutting footpaths, where required.

When and where we'll be working

We will be on site for approximately 10 day shifts and 10 nights shifts, between Wednesday 7 August and Friday 27 September 2024, weather and site conditions permitting. Each work zone (see over for map) may have up to four nights of work in a one-week period.

Our work hours will be as follows:

Saturday	8.00am-1.00pm	

We won't work on Sundays during the day or on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

We need to carry out some work at night to minimise disruption and safety impacts for our road users and our project team.

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise project impacts, including completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Temporary road changes


There will be some temporary road changes during work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

We will not impact access to businesses and homes near the work zone.

Please keep to speed limits indicated and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

When will the bus lane camera system be operational?

The bus lane camera system is expected to be operational by September. A warning period of 31 days will be in place, with caution letters sent out to alert road users of road condition changes.

A bus lane camera system sign will also be visible.
