# Waterfall Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project

August-September 2024

This project is designed to simplify and modernise the rail network, delivering a range of benefits for rail customers through better infrastructure, new trains and extra services.

## What work are we doing?

In August and September 2024, we will be completing finishing work at Waterfall, including:

- site clean-up and compound removal
- remediation of access roads
- rectification work.

## When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours on this project are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am until 1pm on Saturday.

Work will be undertaken in and adjacent to the rail corridor at Waterfall.

#### Key benefits:

- Improved services on the T4 Illawarra Line and South Coast Line
- New intercity trains that will provide a new level of comfort and convenience for passengers travelling between Sydney and the South Coast.

#### **Swift stats:**

- installed five rain gardens in the Royal National Park to improve the quality of water runoff, assist in reducing erosion and provide habitat for wildlife
- re-purposed over 35,000 tonnes of excavated material, improving assets in the Royal National Park including fire trails, roads and walking tracks
- planted 30 different native species with the students of Waterfall Public School into their Uncle Mick Ting memorial garden on the edge of the Royal National Park
- introduced 'zero trim piling', a concrete work method which reduces noise and dust pollution and the impacts of our work on our nearest neighbours – an Australian first
