



Changed traffic conditions on the Newell Highway at Boggabilla from Monday 12 May

Transport for NSW acknowledges Aboriginal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential repair work on the Newell Highway at Boggabilla as part of the Australian Government's Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

What work are we doing?

Boggabilla is one of 19 locations between Gilgandra and the Queensland border where we will be carrying out essential repair work to restore the road surface to a safer and smoother road.

This includes removing damaged pavement and applying a new layer of asphalt.

When and where we'll be working

Works in Boggabilla will take place from **Monday 12 May to Friday 16 May**, weather permitting. We have included a map to show the location of the works.

Work hours will be **7am to 5pm** from **Monday to Friday**.

Works will be carried out in three stages at the following locations:

- **12-13 May:** Merriwa Street (Newell Highway) from the intersection with North Street to about 150 metres north.
- **14-15 May:** North Street (Newell Highway) from the intersection with Merriwa Street for about 150 metres southwest, just past the intersection with Yeoman Street.
- **16 May:** a final asphalt layer will be placed on both Merriwa Street and North Street.

Traffic impacts

For the safety of workers and motorists, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place during work hours. Outside of work hours, the speed limit will revert to the posted limit of 50km/h.

Motorists are advised to drive to conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic control and signage in place
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Some driveway accesses may be impacted near the intersection of North Street and Merriwa Street.

Transport will speak with those residents whose access may be impacted prior to construction works commencing.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise and dust.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- arranging work in stages to minimise impacts to residents, motorists and pedestrians
- using a water truck to dampen the surface.

We understand that this work will generate some inconvenience, and we thank you for your patience.
