

Bus stop location changes at Bankstown Station bus interchange and South Terrace from Monday 14 July 2025

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the land, the Darug people, on which we work. Transport for NSW pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential road maintenance work on the Southwest Link bus route between Belmore and Bankstown to ensure bus services can continue to operate safely and efficiently.

Work at Bankstown Station bus interchange and South Terrace will commence on **Monday 14 July** and is expected to be completed by **Thursday 7 August 2025**.

Bus stop changes

From **Monday 14 July** temporary bus stop changes will be in place while we undertake work at Bankstown Station bus interchange.

When we are resurfacing the road at the Bankstown Station bus interchange:

- the bus drop off and pick up location will be relocated to South Terrace

When we are resurfacing on South Terrace:

- the Southwest Link bus drop off and pick up location will be relocated to Bankstown Station Stand A
- the N40 night rider bus drop off and pick up location will be relocated to West Terrace.

Please see the location map on page 2 for further detail. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist bus users.

When road resurfacing is not taking place, buses will drop off and pick up from their regular locations.

What work are we doing?

Work involves replacing sections of asphalt, repainting road markings and reinstating traffic light detectors.

When will we be working?

We will be working for up to **eight-night shifts** between **Monday 14 July** and **Thursday 7 August 2025**, weather permitting.

The work will include four-night shifts of road resurfacing (asphalting) and four-night shifts of line marking.

We will work between **Sunday to Thursday**, between **8pm** and **5am**, the next day.

Traffic changes and detours

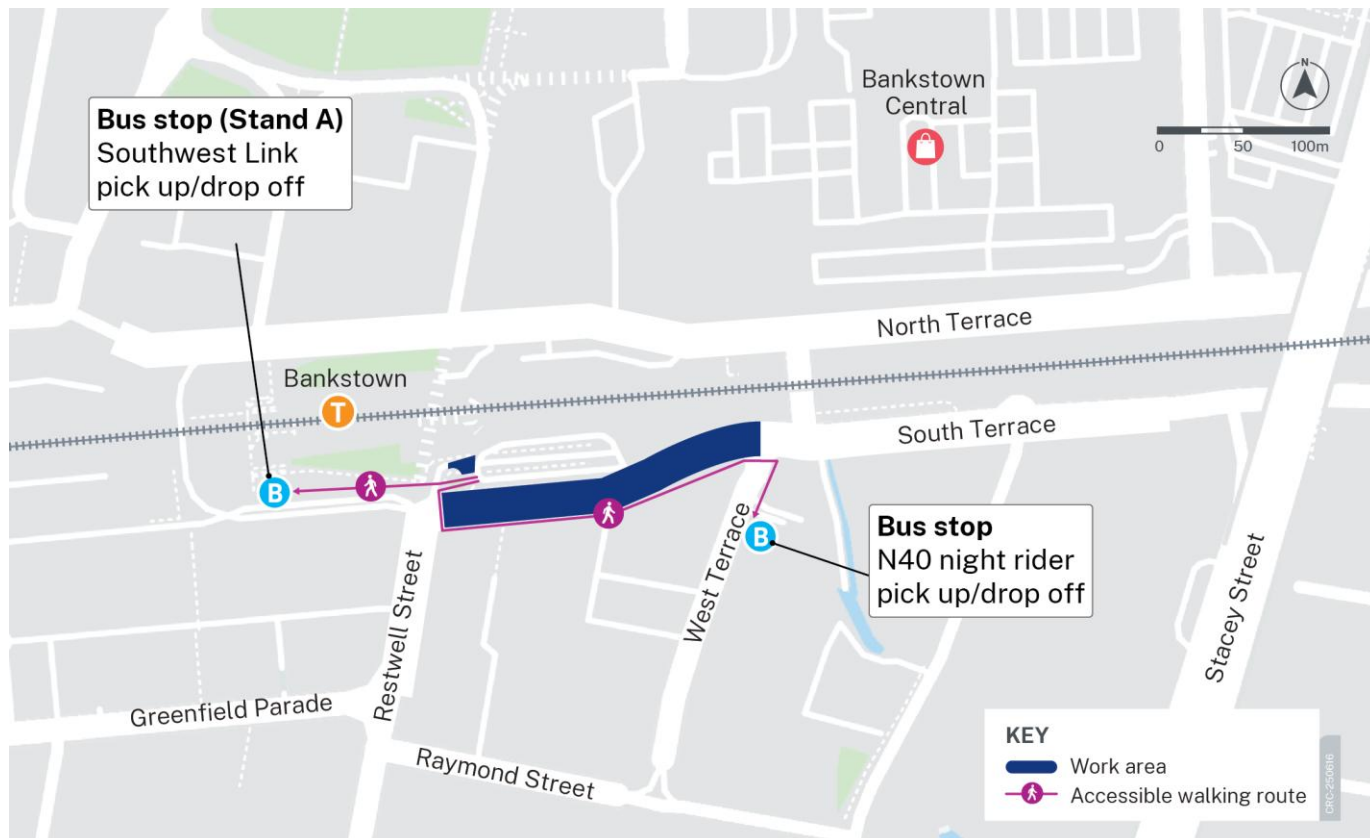
South Terrace will be closed between Restwell Avenue and West Terrace while we carry out road resurfacing and line marking work.

A 40km/h speed limit will be in place overnight and may affect travel times.

Motorists will need to follow the signposted detour route. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

What will this mean for you?

Our work will be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, bus users and motorists.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using quieter equipment, where possible.
